#### **WENDY ORR**

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE**

Wendy Orr was born in Edmonton, Canada in 1953. She spent her childhood in various countries as her father was in the Royal Canadian Air Force. She lived variously in Longuyon, Magny-Metz, Ottawa, Red Deer, Colorado Springs, Toronto and Middleton, Novia Scotia. As a child she read avidly and at eight years of age wrote 'Glossy the Horse', which she said bore a resemblance to *Black Beauty*, a book recently read to her by her mother. Another story, written when she was nine years of age, entitled 'Spring Island' was, she felt, a first draft of *Nim's Island* (1999).

Initially Wendy Orr studied animal husbandry in Kingston, Ontario, but later went to England for the summer but later completed a diploma in occupational therapy at the London School of Occupational Therapy. On a short holiday in Wales, she met an Australian farmer at a Youth Hostel. Six months later they married, and upon her graduation, Orr migrated to Australia with her new husband. They had two children. After nearly 20 years in dairy farming, Wendy and her husband moved to Mornington Peninsula in Victoria where they are restoring the bush to its natural state as a home for wildlife.

Her first book was *Amanda's Dinosaur* (1986), which shared first place in the Ashton Scholastic competition for an unpublished picture book manuscript. It was published in 1988. Rights to this book were subsequently sold to Canada, New Zealand and the United States. In 1993 she left practice as an occupational therapist and became a full-time writer. Shortly thereafter, her book *Leaving It To You* was shortlisted in The Children's Book Council of Australia (CBCA) Awards in 1993. Two years later, *Ark in the Park* won the CBCA Young Readers Award. Her book, *Peeling the Onion*, was chosen as a CBCA Honour Book, selected by the American Library Association as a Best Book for Young Adults, and also by the New York Public Library for its annual bibliography, 'Books for the Teenager'. *Nim's Island* (1999), became a successful Hollywood feature film in 2008 starring Jodie Foster, Abigail Breslin and Gerard Butler. The author describes this five year involvement in the film's creation as 'one of the most amazing and intellectually stimulating times of my life.'

By 2009, Wendy Orr had published over 30 works. She also published under the name Sally George. She writes for various ages and after publishing her adult novel, *The House at Evelyn's Pond* (2001), she plans to alternate writing for adults and children. She writes in many genres and forms including picture books, novellas, novels for teenagers, and in the genres of fantasy and science fiction. Her books have been translated into many languages including Swedish, Portuguese, Taiwanese, Japanese, French, Korean, Lithuanian, Turkish, Slovenian, Greece, Dutch, Thai, Italian, Spanish, Catalan, Basque, Polish, and German as well as appearing in British, America and Canadian editions. Australian critics, Lees and Macintyre describe her work as 'full of humour and intensity, presents the multicultural make-up of the Australian community, its mix of classes, big cities and small country towns. A thematic concern across her work is the development of self and finding one's place in the world.' (Lees & Macintyre in Zipes 2006, p200) Critics in *The Continuum Encyclopedia of Young Adult Literature* describe Orr's work as 'best known for imaginative, adventurous and humorous plots and characters'. (Cullinan, Kunzel & Wooten, 2005, p551).

#### WENDY ORR PAPERS

#### **SCOPE AND CONTENT**

Wendy Orr donated her second consignment of papers and manuscripts under the Cultural Gifts Program in February 2009. The size of this donation is eight standard archival boxes comprising 14 series. The material relates to *Nim's Island*, a feature film based on her book of the same title, which was screened in 2008, novellas and novels published between 2001 and 2007, picture books and a collection of short pieces. Earlier works by this author were among the papers and manuscripts donated under the Cultural Gifts Program in 2000.

The papers comprise material about the author and her career; correspondence; preliminary ideas and research; manuscripts in various drafts with comments from editors and illustrators; draft text and preliminary copies of illustrations for novellas; galleys and proofs with editing; correspondence with US and UK publishers and a French translator; fan mail; and reviews and publicity, particularly surrounding the film, *Nim's Island*. The collection has particular strengths in demonstrating the process of author revision and the author's working relationships with editors and publishers.

The donation also included four overseas editions of the author's works, and an uncorrected proof copy of one novel.

The papers were arranged and described by Dr Belle Alderman AM. The author's initial arrangement of her papers was usually by title, and this arrangement has been followed. Additional information featured in this finding aid, as a result of the arrangement and description, includes dates and extent of manuscripts, the date range of material, and key individuals involved with a title where these were evident. This enables researchers to trace the communication process and various influences on the author's work. Terminology is that used within the papers.

Related material held in the Lu Rees Archives about Wendy Orr includes her earlier donation of papers and manuscripts in 2000, which cover the period from 1987 – 2000. The Archives also holds an extensive collection of Wendy Orr's published works in Australian and overseas editions, and a comprehensive research file on the author's work featuring reviews, articles and wide-ranging material which aid in an understanding of her work.
