There is also a small crease on the left edge. In addition, there is a large patch where the paint has run in the bottom left of the illustration. The illustration has been glued to a cardboard backing piece.

There are also two small black spots near the group of soldiers. The illustration has been glued to a cardboard backing piece.

The Grand Old Duke of York cannot be seen. The number "6", in a circle, is pencilled in the top right corner.	DH 99	Good condition. There is a crease that slightly impinges into the illustration on the left edge. There are also two pencil marks in the centre top and centre left of the piece. The illustration has been glued to a cardboard backing piece.

The number "7", in a circle, is pencilled in the top right corner.	DH 100	Fair condition. It appears the glue used to attach the illustration to the backing piece has wrinkled the whole illustration. In addition, there are noticeable creases in the top and bottom edges as well as a tear in the top right. There are three noticeable stains in the bottom right corner. The condition of the backing sheet is poor with tears in all edges.
