This art piece has been donated to the Lu Rees Archives and was sold by Pinerolo, The Children's Book Cottage, June 2013. Included is the sales label which incorrectly states, "NOELA YOUNG Original endpaper illustration for <i>Pigs Might Fly</i> by Emily Rodda" and in pencil, "NY 1382 \$150". There is no evidence to hand to confirm this illustration was used as the endpaper for the book.	NY 1	Good condition. There is a small, three part, brown mark near the centre right edge.
