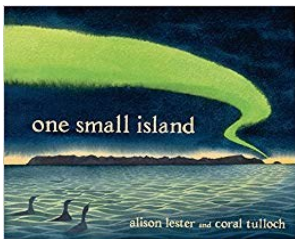
You are invited to come and visit the **Treasures** of the

We hold a growing collection of over 42,000 Australian children's books, authors' papers and manuscripts, artists' artworks, publishers' archives, research material, ephemera and more.

- Artists' creative processes from initial sketch, storyboard, dummy and developmental drawings to final artwork.
- Writers' original manuscripts including Margaret Wild's *Fox* Emily Rodda's *Something Special*, Libby Hathorn's *Way Home* and others.
- View original artwork for *My Two Blankets* written by Irena Kobald and illustrated by Freya Blackwood, Alison Lester and Coral Tulloch's *One Small Island*, Alison's *My Dog Betsy* and Narelle Oliver's *Fox and Fine Feathers*, while chatting with our keepers of the art.
- See some of the 4,200 translations in over 50 languages.
- Discover the research potential waiting in our 420 research files on all major Australian children's writers and illustrators.
- Find suggestions for exploring authors' and illustrators' creative works with young people.
