

#### **WENDY ORR**

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE**

Wendy Orr began writing stories as a small child in Canada but it was not until 1986 (by which time she was married with two children and living on a farm in Australia) that it began as a hobby which possibly might (and did) lead to publication and eventually a full-time occupation. Her first published book was a result of sharing 1<sup>st</sup> prize in the Ashton Scholastic Picture Book Manuscript Award in 1987. The prize was publication of her manuscript. This book was *Amanda's dinosaur*, published in 1988.

Wendy's books, no matter the audience, clearly reflect her background, education, interests and personality. Living in Canada, France and the USA as the child of a member of the Royal Canadian Air Force influenced her greatly whilst writing *The House at Evelyn's Pond*, her only adult novel. Wendy has had a love of, and is inspired by, animals, especially dogs, from a very early age. After leaving school she studied animal care for a year in Kingston, Canada. She has many picture books and books for younger readers about animals. In 2011 and 2012 she had published, in the USA, six books — each one about a different animal. Even when an animal is not the main character, somehow one will manage to appear in her books. Wendy is a qualified occupational therapist. This knowledge and her personal experience of a very serious car accident were instrumental in the writing of *Peeling the onion*. An interest that has spanned several decades is ancient history. In 1989 she completed a manuscript called *The Last priestess* about a servant girl in the Bronze Age on Crete. Although she chose not to pursue this story into publication, the subject matter clearly didn't go away. She has published two books about this very topic - *Dragonfly song* in 2016, followed up by *Swallow's dance* in 2018.

By 2019, Wendy had published 49 works (some of which have only ever been published in Canada or the USA) and several short stories. Many of her books have been shortlisted or won awards in Australia, Canada, USA, Israel and the United Kingdom. She has been shortlisted or won awards for a variety of categories: *Dragonfly song* won in 2017 the Prime Minister's Literary Award for Children's Literature; *Rescue on Nim's Island* won in 2015 the Wilderness Society Environment Award for Children's Literature, Fiction; *Rainbow Street pets* was shortlisted in 2013 for the Speech Pathology Australia Book of the Year Awards, Upper Primary; *Nim's Island* won in 2009 the Mits'ad Hasfarim (The March of books) Award for Most Popular Book for Grades 4-6 in Israel; *The House at Evelyn's Pond* was shortlisted in 2002 for the Australian Audio Book of the Year, *Peeling the onion* won a Children's Book Council of Australia Honour Award for Older readers, 1997 and was shortlisted in 1999 for the NASEN Special Educational Needs Book Awards, UK, and *Ark in the Park* won the Children's Book Council of Australia Book of the Year, Younger Readers, 1995. *Peeling the Onion* was also in the American Library Association's list of the Best 100 Books in the last 50 Years for Young Adults, 1998.

Her books have been translated into 29 languages and published in British, American and Canadian editions. Several books have been published in Braille and made into audio books.

She has had two books made into feature films. *Nim's Island* was made into a successful Hollywood feature film, *Nim's Island*, in 2008. This was followed up in 2013 by the Australian feature film *Return to Nim's Island*, based on the book *Nim at sea*.

#### WENDY ORR PAPERS 2020

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT

Wendy Orr made her third donation of papers and manuscripts relating to many of her works to the National Centre for Australian Children's Literature Inc in October 2017. This present collection spans the years from 1987 to 2016. Although there are papers from Wendy's early years, this collection is primarily from 2001 (*The House at Evelyn's Pond*) to 2016 (*Dragonfly song*).

This donation includes three significant manuscripts from Wendy's early years, all of which are unpublished. *Bunyips of the Billabong* was written in the 1980s, *The Last priestess* was written between 1987 and 1989 and *Kelly Panelli* was written in the late 1990s.

Another significant donation is the collection of personal letters written by the author to her parents over a period of 30 years, starting in 1982. These give a very special insight into the thought processes and challenges of being a creator of stories. These letters are chronologically arranged and documented. References have been made to all stories/books, regardless of whether they were published or not. There are also references to all alternate/short titles/working titles used in the letters.

The size of this collection is 14 standard archival boxes and 1 oversize flat archival box. The oversize box includes a scrapbook (made by Wendy), cards and a book made by school children.

The author usually arranged her papers chronologically by title and this order has been maintained, except in one instance. The papers and manuscripts relating to the unpublished work *The Last priestess* have been included with the papers and manuscripts to *Dragonfly song*. This is in recognition of the influence of *The Last priestess* in the development of *Dragonfly song*. Wendy has written a note explaining her use of research work, the location and some characters from *The Last priestess* when writing *Dragonfly song*.

This collection includes papers relating to an adult novel, young adult novels, junior novels, picture books, short stories, a film, personal letters, fan mail and other general papers. There are numerous manuscripts, including many drafts and rewrites. The papers also include correspondence with Wendy's parents, publishers, editors, publicists, literary agents, festival organisers and many other people and organisations. There are numerous newspaper articles and reviews as well as promotional materials and festival programmes. Some books, eg *The House at Evelyn's Pond*, required extensive research by the author and those research papers are included in this collection. There is numerous correspondence demonstrating the author's relationship with editors and publishers both in Australia and overseas.

The depth of this collection gives an insight into the writing process and the challenges of creating and publishing for children, young adults and adults in various formats. This collection includes a copy of the published book *The Princess and her panther*. This title can be found in the first folder relating to this book.

Papers are listed under the final title of the book. All alternate/short titles/working titles used in the writing/publishing process are indicated in the papers' descriptions.

Earlier works by Wendy Orr are among the papers and manuscripts donated under the Cultural Gifts Program in 2000 and in 2009.
