Celebrating National NAIDOC Week 3 - 10 July 2002


The National Centre for Australian Children's Literature Inc (NCACL) celebrates the history, culture, and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples during National NAIDOC Week 2022. This week provides an opportunity for all Australians to learn more about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. This year's theme is *Get Up! Stand Up! Show Up!* It provides an opportunity to celebrate and recognise the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, the oldest, continuous living cultures on earth.

The National NAIDOC Committee offers freely available resources to support teachers, which are available from their website https://www.naidoc.org.au/resources/educational. These resources address the Australian Curriculum: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Histories and Culture cross-curriculum priority. These are designed for Foundational Studies to Year 12 and may also be relevant to VET and University students undertaking Indigenous Studies.

Our Centre's website offers a freely available database of children's and young adult books by and about Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander Peoples. In 2020, the Australian Government's Department of Education, Skills and Employment funded our Centre to create this database aimed at teachers and others interested. The database continues to grow. By June 2022, over 500 books now feature in this easy-to-use database. A team of knowledgeable people, with wide-ranging perspectives and expertise collaborated to produce this resource. The team included First Nations people and culturally diverse individuals of various ages, genders and backgrounds.

Our Centre has selected 36 books from our database to reflect this year's theme *Get Up! Stand Up!*Show Up! Each book is hyperlinked to our database which provides further details about each book. These books offer a way to feature and share the richness of Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander People's culture, languages and where stories originated. Such books offer a variety of storytelling techniques, genres and illustration styles that entertain, inform, and engage readers. Each resource can be searched by author, title, illustrator, publisher, date, Australian curriculum codes, over 600 subjects, languages, story locations and creators' cultural backgrounds where these are available. Also included are freely available teaching resources that offer additional insights for each book. Free access is available on NCACL's website
