GRAEME BASE

BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE

Graeme Base is a writer and illustrator of stories and books for children. He came to Australia from England with his parents in 1966. During his school years he developed an interest in drawing and music. On leaving school he studied, for 3 years, graphic design at Swinburne Institute of Technology, Melbourne. This study was geared towards advertising and on completion, he joined the advertising workforce. He soon felt unsuited to this field of work. In his spare time he had been doing freelance work illustrating book jackets for publishers, illustrating articles in the Victorian Dept of Education magazines and illustrating other authors' works.

With the advice of, and encouragement from Bob Sessions, a publisher at Penguin Books, Graeme Base took the big step of writing and illustrating his own picture book for children. *My Grandma lived in Gooligulch* was published in 1983. It sold reasonably well and impressed Penguin Books such that they made Base an offer to publish another book. *Animalia* was published in 1986 and gained significant international attention. The book was very quickly published overseas, including by Harry N Abrams, New York. This book was the start of a long relationship with Harry N Abrams and the publishing and selling of Base's books in the USA. It has sold over 3 million copies worldwide. It was also made into an animated TV series in 2007.

Many of his books, eg *The Eleventh hour*, have puzzles, codes and games to solve or hidden items to find in the text and very detailed artwork. So many of his books have many layers besides simply reading the text. He likes to challenge his readers as well as create a book that is highly enjoyable.

Graeme's love of travel and music have significantly influenced his books. *The Sign of the seahorse* and *Jungle drums* are two books influenced by travel. *The Sign of the seahorse* was also made into a stage musical and a musical CD was part of *The Worst band in the Universe*, both written and composed by Graeme.

His books have been translated into Mandarin, Danish, French, German, Hebrew, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Taiwanese and Thai, as well as published in the UK, Canada and the USA.

Graeme has been shortlisted for and won numerous awards for his artwork as well as his books. In 1987 *Animalia* was the Children's Book Council of Australia (CBCA) Picture Book of the Year, Honour award. In 1989 *The Eleventh Hour* was joint winner of the CBCA Picture Book of the Year. In 2000 *The Worst band in the universe* was given an honour award for illustration by the International Board on Books for Young People (IBBY). In 2005 *Jungle drums* won the Speech Pathology Book of the Year for Lower Primary. He also won this award in 2007 for *Uno's garden*. In 2007 *Uno's garden* won the Wilderness Society Australia Environmental Award for Children's Literature. Although not an award, Graeme was honoured to be selected to create the poster for the United Nations International Literacy Year in 1990. He has also created artworks to support many charities both in Australia and overseas.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Graeme Base made this donation of papers relating to many of his works for young people and artwork to the National Centre for Australian Children's Literature Inc in 2020. The collection spans the years from 1981 to 2015.

The size of this collection is seven standard archival boxes and one oversize flat archival box. The oversize box includes award certificates, posters, competition stickers and a promotional pack.

The collection includes papers relating to picture books, artwork, calendars, a frieze, a colouring book, a television series, CDs, films, a videotape, a concert, CD ROM and other general papers.

The papers have been organised chronologically from oldest to most recent within categories. The papers include correspondence with publishers, editors, literary agents and other people and organisations. This collection includes many tour itineraries and related matters in Australia, England, Canada and the United States. There is much evidence (including correspondence) of being shortlisted for, or winning, awards in Australia and overseas. Many of these awards are also included in this collection. There are numerous newspaper articles and book reviews (primarily from Australia and the United States) as well as promotional materials.

Graeme Base has regularly used his artwork to raise funds for numerous organisations, eg Red Cross Bushfire Appeal, Victorian Animal Aid Trust and Starbright Foundation (United States). His artwork has also been exhibited in many places in Australia, especially in Victoria.

Between 1981 and 1983, the author illustrated several articles for *Challenge* and *Explorer*, children's magazines published by the Victorian Dept of Education. These illustrations were unacknowledged by the publishers but were verified by the artist. These magazines are included in this collection.

The depth of this collection gives an insight into the writing and illustrating process and the challenges of creating and publishing for children.

As part of this Australian Government Cultural Gifts Donation, the author donated a significant number of his books that have been translated into languages other than English. These books have been added to the National Centre for Australian Children's Literature Inc collection.
