

Bibliography of NCACL books for NAIDOC Week 2023 **'For Our Elders'**

The National Centre for Australian Children's Literature Inc (NCACL) celebrates the history, culture, and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples during National NAIDOC Week 2023. This week provides an opportunity for all Australians to learn more about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. This year's theme is *For Our Elders*.

The NAIDOC website explains that in the early 1990s there was a growing awareness of the depth and richness of First Nations Culture and NADOC was expanded to recognise the distinct separate culture of the Torres Strait Islander peoples. The name was then changed to NAIDOC and the celebration was expanded to one day to a week and became known as the 'National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee' (NAIDOC). The NAIDOC committee respectfully acknowledges the use of the now defunct and inaccurate term 'Aborigines' whilst retaining the term in the committee's name out of respect for the **Elders** who established this celebration in 1938.

NAIDOC Week provides an opportunity to celebrate and recognise the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, the oldest, continuous living cultures on earth.

Our Centre has selected twenty books from our database to reflect this year's theme **For Our Elders**. Each book is hyperlinked to our database which provides further details about each book. These books offer a way to feature and share the richness of Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander People's culture, languages and where stories originated. Such books offer a variety of storytelling techniques, genres and illustration styles that entertain, inform, and engage readers. Each resource can be searched by author, title, illustrator, publisher, date, Australian curriculum codes, over 600 subjects, languages, story locations and creators' cultural backgrounds where these are available. Also included are freely available teaching resources that offer additional insights for each book.

A number of these titles are on display at the National Centre for Australian Literature which located in The Hub at the University of Canberra.
