SOPHIE MASSON

BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE

Sophie Masson was born in 1959 in Jakarta, Indonesia. Her parents were both born in France and with Sophie and her siblings, the family emigrated to Australia in 1963.

Her French and Spanish (on her mother's side) heritage has played a significant part in her knowledge and interests. This became evident when she started writing her books. She is particularly interested in Celtic mythology, European historical fiction and Australian historical fiction. She graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree from Sydney University, followed up by a Master's degree in English and French Literature from the University of New England. Her first manuscript, *The Golden land*, was completed in 1987 but was never published. Finally in 1990 she had her first novel published *-The House in the rainforest*. This was quickly followed in the same year by *Fire in the sky*. From 1990 until 2000, she wrote over 20 novels in the adult, young adult and children's genres. It took until the year 2000 for her to finally become a full-time writer. By 2025 Sophie Masson has written over 90 novels for adults, young adults and children. This includes four novels written in 2008-2010 under the pseudonym of Isabella Merlin and two novels written in 2013 under the pseudonym of Jenna Austen.

Since 1992 she has been shortlisted for many awards in Australia and has been a winner on three occasions. In 2002, she won the Aurealis Award for Excellence in Australian Speculative Fiction — Young Adult Division — Best Novel, for *The Hand of glory*. This was followed in 2011 when she won the New South Wales Premier's Literary Awards — Patricia Wrightson Prize for Children's Books for *The Hunt for Ned Kelly*. Her most recent book, *Bold Ben Hall*, was the winner in 2025 of the New South Wales Premier's History Prize — Young People's History Prize.

Sophie Masson, as an author, has also contributed to the Australian scene by accepting a three year appointment to the Literature Board of the Australia Council in 2004. She has also been a member of the Children's Book Council of Australia, the New South Wales Writers' Centre and the Australian Society of Authors. In 2022, she branched out, with the illustrator Lorena Carrington, and established a small publishing company called Pardolote Press in the New England area of NSW where she lives.

In 2019 Sophie Masson became a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) in recognition of her significant services to literature.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The donation of these papers by Sophie Masson spans the years 1987 to 2005. The size of this collection is 4 standard archival boxes.

The collection contains papers relating to 3 junior fiction titles and 9 young adult titles. Of the latter, *The Golden land* (written in 1987) was never published. The papers have been organised chronologically from oldest to most recent. They include manuscripts, proofs, photocopies of artwork and correspondence with publishers, editors, illustrators and other people and organisations. The author also wrote explanatory notes to accompany some of her papers.

This collection gives an insight into the writing process and the challenges of creating and publishing for children and young adults.

Papers are listed under the final title of each book. All working titles used in the writing/publishing process are indicated in the papers' descriptions.
