Exhibition and associated activities relating to *The Midnight Gang*

The Mura Gadi Gallery at the University of Canberra Library is holding an exhibition of 36 original artworks from *The Midnight Gang* running from Monday 9 February - Friday 27 Feb 2026. Both author and illustrator will appear at the Opening (date in Feb tba). The National Centre for Australian Children's Literature holds the original and preliminary artwork, papers and manuscripts for this book. The NCACL also holds multiple reviews and articles about this book. These provide additional insights and form the basis for a program of activities based on this collection. Three experienced Canberra teachers are designing programs for group sessions of all ages. The Exhibition is open during University semesters Monday-Friday from 10.30am-4.30pm and by arrangement on the weekends.

Well known and much-loved story

The Midnight Gang is a long-time favourite picture book familiar to many children and their caregivers. The story was written by Margaret Wild and illustrated by Ann James, both well-known, respected and award-winning creators. This particular picture book has won prizes for both literary and artistic high quality. It has garnered several awards given by children across Australia – including Canberra. It has been translated and republished several times in new editions.

The Story

Baby Brenda exits her house via the cat flap to meet up with her toddler gang of three. They enjoy nights of great adventure while their unsuspecting families sleep. What do adventurous babies do at night? They ride high on swings, hurl themselves to the moon, catapult onto stars, and cling to the roller-coaster tail of a comet. And that's just for starters!
